



Owens Recreation Center 2019-2020 Winter Adult Hockey League

The adult hockey league is for anyone age 18 and above and offers various skill divisions based on population of the league. Actual divisions may vary. This is a NO CHECK and NO FIGHT league. There are 16 regular season games and a double elimination tournament. Games are one hour and fifteen minutes in length with three 23-minute periods (running time).

Division-A High Caliber Experienced Players/Teams, **Division-B** Average to Intermediate Players/Teams, **Division-C** New Players to Beginners/Teams. Owens Center's League Manager reserves the right to place players and/or teams in the appropriate division.

In the event there are not enough players to hold a division, those players will be assigned to teams in the next level down or offered a refund.

Rosters: No team rosters will be accepted for the C Division. It is strongly suggested that players having participated in Division C for more than 3 years move up to the next division. C Division evaluations (numbers permitting) will be October 6th at 4pm - Mandatory for all players. If transportation or other reasons require a player to be on the same team as another player every effort will be made to accommodate the request. Protected team rosters will be accepted with payment in full. (A full roster includes 16 skaters and two goalies.). *The League Manager will assign players to teams as needed after the roster submittal deadline of September 13, 2019.

Play is based on a combination of USA Hockey and Owens Center Adult Hockey League rules. Full rules may be found at <http://www.peoriaparks.org/hockey-leagues> and begins approximately Saturday, October 19, 2019. Game times will be rotated between the divisions each week with an on ice official for each game. Schedules will be available on or before October 17, 2019. **Game schedule may include inter-division play.** Registrations will not be accepted without full payment and the completed form with the waiver signed.

WARNING OF RISK – ICE SKATING

Ice-skating is intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of the participant. The very nature of ice- skating is risky, including but not limited to slip and falls, colliding with other players of varying degrees of skill (including being struck from behind), tripping on irregular ice surfaces, cuts from skate blades, inadequate or defective equipment, ill-fitting skates, failure in supervision or instruction, horseplay, carelessness, poor technique, poor conditioning, rule violations, striking a stationary object, premises defects outside the rink, and all other risks inherent to the sport of ice-skating. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the (District/SRA) to guarantee absolute safety.

WARNING OF RISK – HOCKEY

Hockey is a sport intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to head/brain injury, cervical spine injury (including paralysis) and death. All hazards and dangers cannot be foreseen. The very nature of the game of hockey is hazardous and risky, including but not limited to being tripped, body-checked, cross-checked with the stick, hit with a slash, a high stick, or a thrown stick, going head first into the boards, getting pushed or checked from behind, being cut by a skate blade, colliding with goal posts, being hit by a stick, puck, or other player's protective equipment, elbowed in the head or face, collisions with other players and stationary objects, poor officiating, injuries caused by failure to wear adequate protective equipment, inadequate playing conditions, defective equipment, imperfections in the ice, failure in supervision or instruction, unsportsmanlike conduct, and all other circumstances inherent to sport of hockey. In this regard, it is impossible for the (District/SRA) to guarantee absolute safety.

Please read this form carefully and be aware in registering yourself, your child or ward from participation in this program you will be waiving and releasing all claims from injuries you or your minor child/ward might sustain arising out of this program. As a participant in the program or the parent/guardian of a participant in the program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injuries, including death, damages or loss which I or my minor child/ward may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with such program. I agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have as a result of participating in the program against the Peoria Park District and its officers, agents, servants and employees. I do hereby fully release and discharge the Peoria Park District and its officers, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims from injuries, including death, damage or loss which I or my minor/ward may have or which may accrue to me or my minor/ward on account of my participation in the program. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the Peoria Park District and its officers, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims resulting from injuries, including death, damages and losses sustained by me or my minor/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of the program. In case of accident or sickness, I consent to emergency medical care provided by ambulance or hospital personnel.
