1. CALL TO ORDER

Trustee Joyce Harant called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

3. MINUTES

2.A. Approval of February 7, 2023 Planning Committee Meeting Minutes

Vice President Covington moved to approve the minutes of February 7, 2023.

Motion seconded by Executive Director Cahill and carried on unanimous voice vote.

4. NEW BUSINESS

4.A. Presentation: CO2 Pipeline Through South Side

Joyce Blumenshine of the Central Illinois Healthy Community Alliance and the Heart of Illinois Group Sierra Club gave a presentation regarding concerns on a proposed high-pressure carbon dioxide pipeline through the south side of Peoria. *Please see Attachment A.* In summary, there are many concerns regarding CO2 pipelines including their safety, damage to topsoil and thus reducing crop yield, few governmental regulations, and the fact that eminent domain supersedes landowner rights in the installation of the pipeline.

Trustee Sierra asked what the Planning Committee can specifically do about this. Trustee Harant stated that she would like to explore how the committee can keep track of the project. Emily Cahill stated that the District would like to learn more about this in order to articulate the potential impact it would have on the District. This committee would potentially vet this idea and then recommend some course of action to the Board. She would like to learn more about this and see how it would fit into the District's Commitment to Environmental Sustainability and Commitment to Diversity Equity Inclusion and Accessibility and then recommend a course of action and/or advocacy.

4.B. Bradley Park Artwork Request

An email from the Uplands Residential Association President James Hinchee was sent to the Park Board Trustees concerning public art in Bradley Park. The email asserts that the Park District should pay for a statue in Bradley Park, replacing a statue taken down in 2020. Trustee Harant stated that she and President Johnson attended an Uplands Residential Association meeting last fall, informing them of the new Board-approved policy that addresses statues and artwork in District spaces. She stated that it was told to the association that PPD does not pay for the statue or artwork, that according to the policy, other private funding would be necessary. The Planning Committee members discussed the Uplands request and by consensus, it was agreed that the District will make a reaffirmation of the policy. The committee would like staff to draft a letter to Mr. Hinchee from President Johnson, reiterating the policy and providing additional information.

4.C. Parks Division – Monthly Work Order Report

Matt Freeman presented the Work Order Reports for November and December 2022 and January 2023. *Please see Attachment B.*

4.D. Urban Forestry – Natural Urban Development

Trustee Sierra stated that he redrafted the Natural Urban Development Concept Proposal. *Please see Attachment C.* He felt there was a loss of messaging and poor marketing when it came to the communicating of District's intent in getting involved in redevelopment conversations around McKinley and Harrison school sites. Trustee Sierra would like this committee to review the document and discuss and agree to his definition of "What is an Urban Development?" in the proposal document. A copy of the redrafted proposal was provided to those in attendance and discussion ensued. Through a lengthy and thought-provoking discussion, Trustee Sierra stated he would like to stay with the original document/proposal that was passed through this committee (not the redrafted proposal) until the advocacy arm can be built out and elaborate on the environmental and social impacts.

4.E. Trewyn Park Celebrations

Emily Cahill stated that the week of April 10 is National Community Development Week. As such, on Tuesday, April 11, tentatively, the District will conduct a joint press conference and ribbon cutting with the City of Peoria at Trewyn Park for the park updates. On June 27 from 4-7 pm, a community party and celebration will be hosted in conjunction with The Streets Belong to Me. Peoria Grown will be celebrated in addition to other initiatives held during the summer.

5. PENDING BUSINESS

5.A. Outstanding Action Items

Peoria Heights Park/Playground Tour Analysis

Trustee Harant stated that she is happy with the recommendation document presented. A lengthy discussion took place concerning the Park District's role in other villages/municipalities that are part of the Peoria Park District and more specifically, to what extent does the District contribute individual support.

Springdale Savanna Update

Emily Cahill stated that an easement draft has been received by the City. Attorney Streeter and staff have reviewed and sent back to the City for their review and comments. A meeting with the Springdale Authority is scheduled for tomorrow morning in which a draft of the agreement will be discussed. A meeting with Maurer Stutz is set to agree upon where the pins will be set. The City has not yet indicated if an extension beyond April 1 will be needed.

Donovan Sculpture Garden

A meeting was held with David Pittman. They are in process with the artists to extend their agreement for a year to fall of 2024 so they can continue to work to organize with funding and maintenance as PPD cannot do that.

6. OTHER BUSINESS

6.A. Update on Green Banking

Emily Cahill stated that herself, city, county and others attended a meeting about a grant the Illinois Finance Authority is writing around environmental initiatives. They are looking for assistance in determining the structure of the grant communities. Cahill shared that she asked for technical assistance in knowing how to spend the dollars available in order to provide the greatest impact.

6.B. Illinois Finance Authority

6.C. Recent Grants for Purchase Land and Lakeview Splash Pad

Becky Fredrickson stated that the District received the OSLAD grant for the acquisition of a parcel adjacent to Detweiller Park in addition to the funds for a splash pad at Lakeview Park. In addition to those two grants, the District was approached by the City of Peoria that because the District did such a great job with the Trewyn Park project, they came back stating they had additional funding for possible improvements at Logan and Morton Square Parks. The City will look at MLK Park possibly next year. The improvements at Logan and Morton Square Parks would have to be completed by October. As the District progresses through the plans and it is such a short turnaround time, concepts will be presented to the Planning Committee and the public in a quick fashion.

6.D. African American Hall of Fame

Trustee Harant stated that she attended the Black History Month presentation at Proctor Center, she walked through the African American Hall of Fame room and would like to upgrade it and/or find a better location for it. Emily Cahill will contact Rosemary McCullough to get feedback and discuss.

6.E. Benches on the Trail

Trustee Harant inquired if there is a possibility to have more benches installed on the Rock Island Trail. Mike Friberg stated that there are only a few benches on the trail due to challenges with the spacing of benches that would accommodate mowers. Emily Cahill stated that staff is working to research how other park districts handle memorials in hopes of streamlining the request process for benches and other memorial. Benches are increasingly more expensive and may not be a price point affordable for everyone. Currently, the PPD Marketing team has an inventory of memorial benches the District can offer along with the current standardized process to follow.

7. ACTION STEPS REVIEW

1. Research the impacts of a CO2 pipeline and if there are steps that PPD can take.
2. Draft a letter to the Uplands Residential Association to be signed by President Johnson tomorrow.
3. Trustee Sierra will let Emily Cahill know when there will be a meeting with PHA concerning the urban development proposal.
4. Work on preparation for the Peoria Heights discussion on April 11.
5. Emily Cahill will contact Rosemary McCullough concerning the African American Hall of Fame.

Concerns for the Peoria Park District Regarding a High-Pressure Carbon Dioxide Pipeline

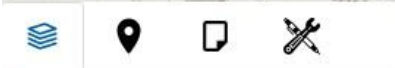
Wolf ADM Mt. Simon Hub pipeline map available in 2022



Pipeline appears to come into the Peoria South Side near the river corridor.

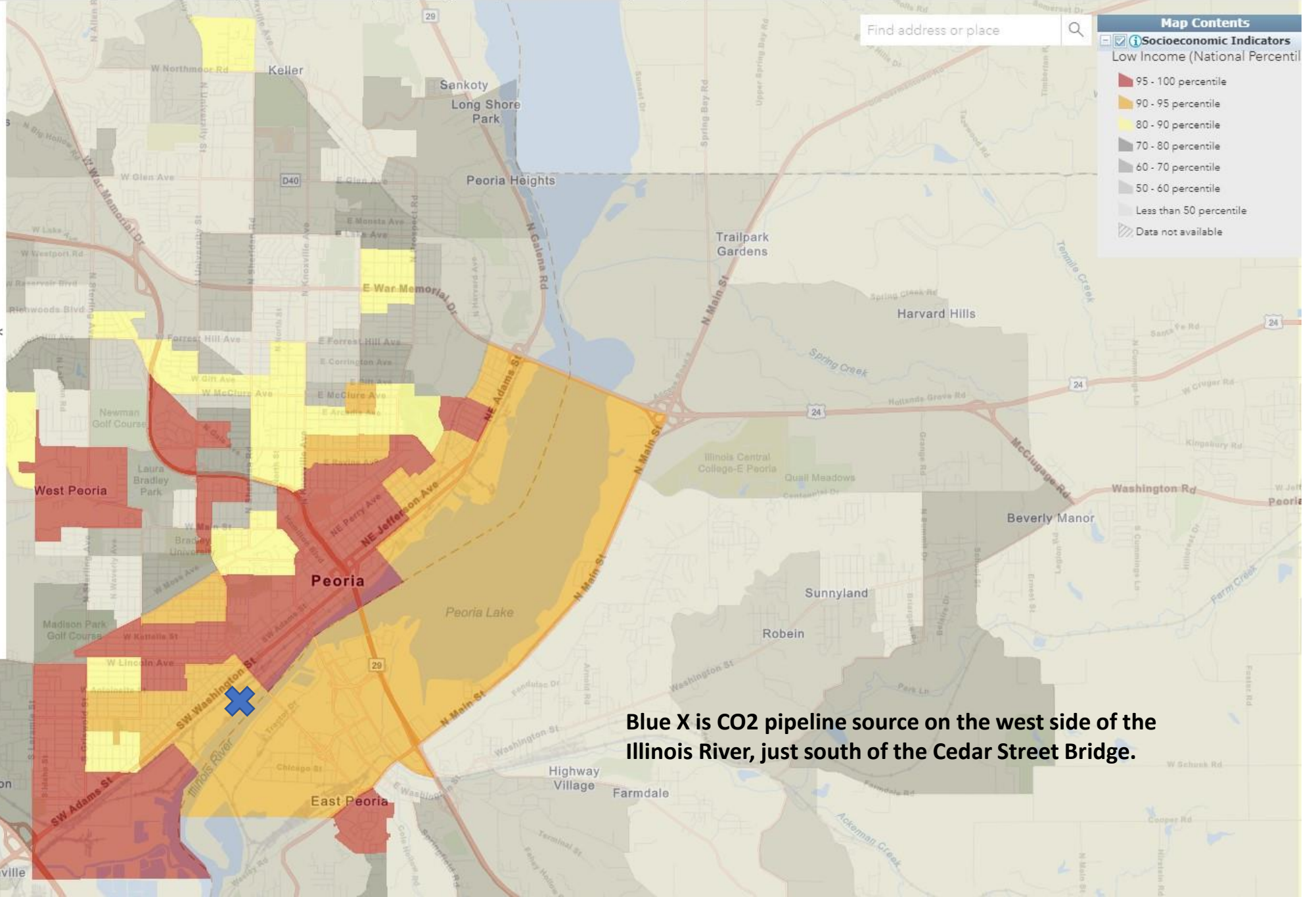

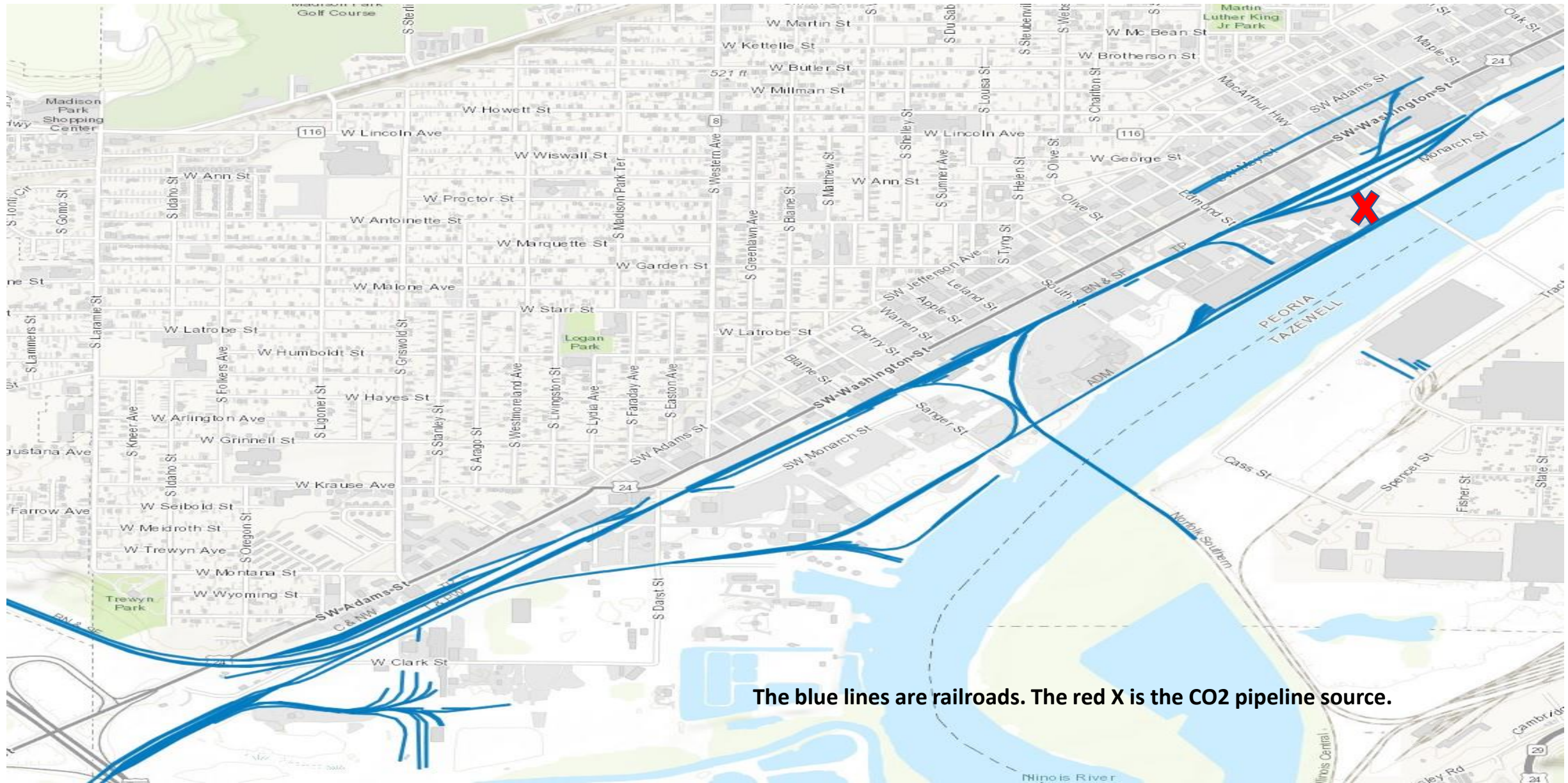

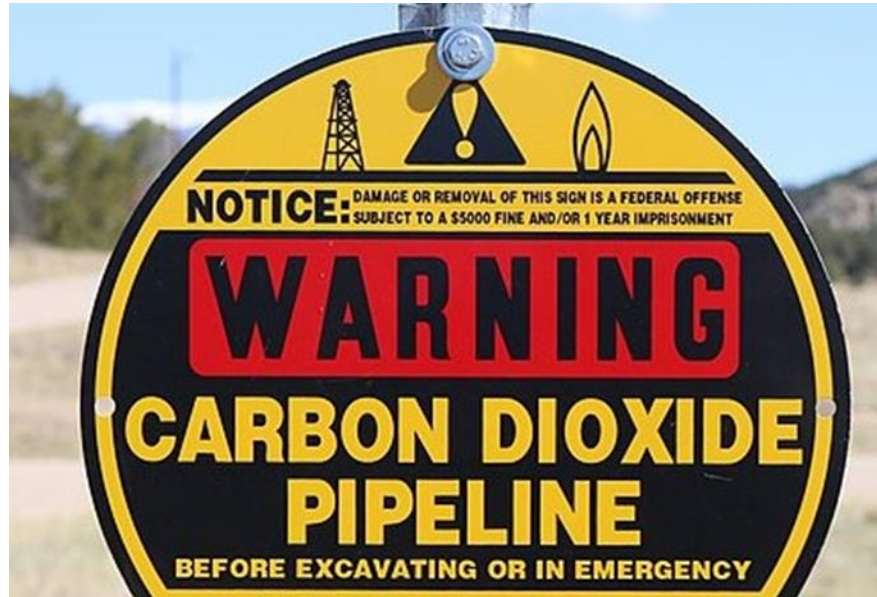
The CO2 lateral line will extend into the south side of Peoria along the east side of the 61605 zip code area to the BioUrja plant in zip code 61602. The surroundings are U.S. EPA designated Environmental Justice areas due to multiple factors including minority population and poverty level. These areas *may be potentially* within one mile of the CO2 line. The CO2 pipeline lateral could be from 6" to 8 " diameter but the size is not yet known. It is expected some of the line will be along a railroad corridor from the south.



The blue lines are railroads. The red X is the CO2 pipeline source.

Carbon Dioxide Pipelines are Hazardous.

A line failure can mean damage to property and loss of life.



- CO2 pipelines are regulated by the U.S. Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, which is currently reviewing regulations due to a pipeline break about one mile from Satartia, MS. Their review is expected to be completed in 2024.
- Illinois CO2 pipeline regulations are under the Illinois Commerce Commission and were written for the FutureGen coal to gas project in 2011. They lack adequate public health and safety requirements for the extent of CO2 lines coming into Illinois and rely on the PHMSA regulations. A CO2 pipeline one mile from Satartia, MS, ruptured in February, 2020

- The Satartia area 24 inch diameter CO2 line break released CO2 for four hours
- The rupture blew a trench 40 feet deep
- Soil erosion from heavy rains was blamed for the line break
- 200 people were evacuated and 45 went for hospital treatment
- CO2 displaces oxygen and is an asphyxiant at high levels
- Emergency responders found people unconscious in cars, walking in circles, foaming at the mouth and in other states of being overcome by CO2

Questions that Need to Be Asked:

What are the risks & costs to the Peoria Park District regarding a CO2 pipeline?

What are typical First Responder times needed to reach park areas?

What are the long-term implications of CO2 pipelines:

- Lack of requirements/funding for decommissioning?**
- Who really pays in case of property damages, loss of life?**

Steps the Peoria Park District Could Consider:

- 1) Consider endorsing a temporary moratorium on the approval of construction and operation of any carbon dioxide pipeline in Peoria until the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration promulgates its revised federal safety standards for transportation of carbon dioxide, expected to be completed in October 2024.
- 2) Consider Park District interests in filing as an Intervenor whenever the Wolf ADM companies file to the Illinois Commerce Commission for the required state permit for pipeline construction. The only way to have concerns considered in deliberations is to be an Intervenor or join a group Intervening in the case.

EIGHT CONCERNS REGARDING CO₂ PIPELINES

Why Oppose CO₂ Pipelines

With concerns looming large over our ability to reduce climate-changing greenhouse gas emissions from power and industrial plants, the federal government is making billions of dollars available to private corporations to capture these emissions and pump them underground. This requires transporting high pressure carbon dioxide many miles from the industrial source to the site of storage.

The Wolf ADM “Mt. Simon Hub” project will be 280 miles long from Iowa through Illinois. As it currently appears, it will cross parts of Rock Island, Henry, Knox, Stark, Peoria, Tazewell, McClean, Logan, DeWitt, and end in Macon County. It will collect and transfer CO₂ from Iowa and Illinois, and possibly at some point, other sources, to underground storage facilities in Illinois. But, there are many reasons why this is not a good idea. Here are eight:

#1. CO₂ Pipelines Aren't Safe

In order to transport the carbon via pipeline, it must be liquified and pressurized at 3 times the rate of natural gas. CO₂ pipelines can, and do, rupture or leak. When this occurs, an explosive plume of CO₂ gas can emerge that is odorless and colorless. CO₂ is heavier than air and displaces oxygen. It will accumulate in low areas. Because it is an asphyxiant, the plume can suffocate at high levels. Internal combustion engines in gas-powered vehicles may not run. These dangers can extend up to a mile from the point of rupture, depending on the amount of CO₂ released.

A February, 2020, CO₂ pipeline rupture in Mississippi required the evacuation of more than 200 people and put 45 in the hospital. While no one died, many experienced life-threatening symptoms. Emergency responders had difficulty rescuing people. Details of this CO₂ pipeline rupture and impacts are in the article online [“The Gassing of Satartia”](#) (Huffington Post, August 2021).

#2. Eminent Domain Supersedes Landowner Rights

If Wolf ADM is granted eminent domain, landowners will have no say over whether a carbon pipeline company can build through their property. This is particularly true in Illinois. The state has adopted the [Carbon Dioxide Transportation and Sequestration Act](#) that, as currently written, establishes carbon capture as a public good, a key criterion for enabling eminent domain. Leases from another company for these pipelines indicate they are forever meaning if the property is sold or transferred, the company still has rights to access the pipeline and possibly adjust the location within the agreed right-of-way.

The Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) can regulate routing, and MAY consider landowner objections to the pipeline based on safety, if many intervene. For that reason, people are urge that they **NOT SIGN A VOLUNTARY EASEMENT**. Doing so will waive future rights. The only way to have issues of concern be considered in an ICC pipeline permit case is for city, county, groups and or individuals or other officials file to intervene in the proceedings.

#3. Pipeline Construction Damages Topsoil and Reduces Crop Yield

Landowner experience with the Dakota Access Pipeline has shown that the fertility of cropland can be adversely impacted by construction. A [2021 Iowa State University](#) study found “extensive soil disturbance from construction activities had adverse effects on soil physical properties, resulting from mixing of topsoil with backfill brought in for filling pipeline trenches; and soil compaction from heavy machinery. ”These impacts can discourage root growth and reduce water infiltration in the right-of-way. The research team found:

“Crop yields in the right-of-way were reduced by an average of 25% for soybeans and 15% for corn during the first and second crop seasons, compared to undisturbed fields.”

#4. Few Regulations Exist for CO₂ Pipelines.

Federal oversight is limited. In 1988, Congress expressly assigned responsibility for CO₂ pipeline safety to the Department of Transportation (DOT). In response, the American Petroleum Institute (API) petitioned the DOT for a rulemaking, and then in its comments recommended against writing new regulations specifically for CO₂ pipelines.

EIGHT CONCERNS REGARDING CO₂ PIPELINES

This was because the API claimed a new set of regulations specific to CO₂ pipelines would unnecessarily complicate matters for pipeline operators and the DOT.

The DOT agreed, and so decided not to conduct a detailed analysis of the need for safety standards unique to CO₂ pipelines. Instead, the DOT elected to make CO₂ pipelines subject to the same general standards that existed for oil pipelines, despite the fact that CO₂ is nothing like oil. The exception to this was a new code (49 CFR §195.111) related to the risk of “fracture propagation,” also called “running ductile fractures.” This occurs when a rupture of a CO₂ pipeline results in the pipeline unzipping with explosive force along its length for considerable distances. Rather than prescribe detailed standards to stop these unique fractures, the DOT elected to allow operators “to determine the best method to mitigate a propagating fracture.” This decision, along with applying standards of oil pipelines, elevates concerns over the risks and hazards associated with CO₂ pipelines.

Illinois regulations for the pipelines are outdated and rely to a great extent on the U.S. Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), however, those federal regulations are under review due to investigation into the 2020, Satartia, MS, pipeline rupture. Section 30 of the Illinois Carbon Dioxide Transportation and Sequestration Act refers to the PHMSA regulations as a major part of safety guidelines for Illinois.

#5. Pipelines Extend the Life of Fossil Fuel Use

Instead of spending money to more rapidly deploy renewable energy technologies, billions of federal dollars are being spent to keep the fossil fuel industry in business. This is particularly true for projects that involve enhanced oil recovery (EOR) which uses carbon dioxide to pump more oil out of existing wells. If the pipeline network was eventually expanded to other areas of the state, this process would perpetuate the use of fossil fuels at a time when scientists are clearly saying we need to keep them in the ground.

#6. CO₂ Pipelines Are Funded by the Taxpayer

[Section 45Q](#) of the Internal Revenue Code provides tax credits on a per-ton basis to companies that successfully trap, sequester and store carbon emissions, preventing them from entering the atmosphere. The tax benefit can be shared among the industrial (or power generation) sources, pipeline developers, and carbon sequestration facilities.

Bipartisan proposals increased this credit from \$50 a ton to \$85 a ton, further accelerating this “mad dash” to build pipelines for corporate profit, but at the expense of the taxpayer, who also bears the brunt of the risk (health, unsuccessful projects, damaged farmland, etc.).

#7. For People Near the Pipeline, It's All Risk and No Reward. Corporations profit from carbon capture and sequestration via federal tax credits and low-interest loans. People living near a pipeline and property owners take all the risk, with little to no reward. Landowners are compensated initially for the use of their land, but

payments from pipeline companies do not last as long as the pipelines will be there. Renewable energy technologies such as wind and solar have higher payments and also benefits power to the grid. Land leased by a solar or wind developer pays annually in long-term, revenue-sharing agreements, for the life of the project.

There are far better ways of reducing carbon emissions from industrial plants than capturing the processed CO₂. Converting these plants to use renewably generated electricity would reduce CO₂ emissions and cost less. But, the companies would have to pay for that themselves. Sequestering CO₂ is largely paid for by taxpayers. Carbon capture typically requires more energy and can result in release of more CO₂ than what is sequestered.

#8 CCS Hasn't Worked

Despite extensive support, [80% of the projects](#) that have attempted to commercialize carbon capture and sequestration technology, have ended in failure. Between 2005 and 2012, the Department of Energy spent \$6.9 billion attempting to demonstrate the feasibility of CCS for coal, BUT [less than 4%](#) of the planned capacity of CO₂ was deployed.

Due to the large amount of energy required to power carbon capture and the life cycle of fossil fuels, carbon capture in the U.S. has actually put more CO₂ [into the atmosphere](#) than it has removed. (Sekera, J., Lichtenberger, A. *Assessing Carbon Capture: Public Policy, Science, and Societal Need. Biophys Econ Sust* **5**, 14. 2020).

River Ring



[Bjarke Ingels Group \(BIG\)](#) is lending its sustainable design and urban planning know-how to a novel New York proposal. Scheduled for completion in the next five years, the [River Ring](#) development aims to transform a former fuel-oil storage site in Williamsburg, Brooklyn into a vibrant waterfront with two striking residential towers, also designed by BIG, which will house 1,000 rental apartments (about 250 units are slated as affordable housing). The namesake “ring” is a circular boardwalk connecting visitors to the beach, planned nature trails, and viewpoints fashioned from old oil-storage infrastructure, while the public park and beach will serve as a sort of barrier to rising sea levels. The 3.5-acre project is developed by [Two Trees Management](#) with landscape architecture by [James Corner Field Operations](#)—the team that is also revitalizing the former Domino Sugar Refinery down the street—and could safeguard more than 500 inland properties from flooding during the next Hurricane Sandy-level storm. “We’re changing something from an industrial past into a greener future,” says BIG partner Kai-Uwe Bergmann.

We are proposing that the Peoria Park District and the City of Peoria collaborate as key partners to reach out to other key stakeholders such as: PHA, PPS, 61605 neighborhood groups, not-for-profits, and additional stakeholders to seek their engagement and interest to refine and implement the creation of a restored southern bluff urban development on the site of the one or both former school sites – Harrison and McKinley. The natural development could be viewed as an anchor to reimagine how neighborhood enhancement could evolve concentrically around residential housing, urban areas, green space, and forestry.

A suggested objective is to engage local residents (especially those within a 10-minute walking distance) touched by the key stakeholders (including local indigenous communities with knowledge of the land and its history) to learn about what natural designs, forests, and habitats had been here when indigenous Native Americans lived on the land and how the people and land changed over time to get where it is today. Transforming one or both former school sites to urban developments can be used to empower current local residents to understand that change is within reach; incentivize and attract future residents and businesses; and create intersections for natural areas, residences, technology, education, and more. The result of restoring a natural area can be leveraged to cultivate a sense of belongingness in a neighborhood, develop a practice of taking care of the natural area, and use this urban design to find peace and the beauty of nature.

Our Community Area for Growth in Zip Code 61605

Study after study issued for the City of Peoria has shown that the 61605 zip code area has historically suffered from disinvestment and has been subject to various industrial pollutants. The area is burdened with dilapidated housing and vacant lots. Monica Hendrickson, the Administrator of the Peoria City/County Health Department stated at the June 14, 2022 City Council meeting, "It is important that residents do not continue to return to the same living conditions that have contributed to their health decline". This health decline encompasses every physical, mental, and emotional factor.

The declined status of the 61605 zip code is explainable.

According to 'Urban Blight and Public Health', composed by Columbia University's Erwin de Leon and Urban Institute's Joseph Schilling, individuals spend approximately two-thirds of their time in the area of their residency, which varies in configuration, air quality, well-being, and much more.¹

Our Community Area for Growth in Zip Code 61605 (continued)

For people who reside in poverty-stricken, penurious neighborhoods, their day-to-day lives are negatively impacted by deteriorating infrastructure, food deserts, and a lack of intentionally developed green infrastructure. In heightened underserved communities and pockets of poverty, it is commonly associated to have crude, below-par infrastructure that has been directly linked to declining communal health. "Exposure to poor indoor air, quality, mold, lead, and rodent and cockroach infestations can lead to asthma and other respiratory illnesses, lead poisoning, learning and behavioral problems, and other serious health issues".

Available relevant data, specifically via the Peoria County Health Department's '[Health Indicator Report](#)', shows that the 61605 zip code experiences the challenges listed above. Moreover, current census reports show that in light of many of these challenges, people are moving out of the area, leaving behind vacant homes in poor condition. The average median income in this area is \$21,527 and unemployment rates are at least 9.0%. Violence is also a critical issue in this area. The problems listed above go hand in hand with a decline in economic opportunity, lower academic achievement, an uptick in crime and violence, and increasing mental health challenges.

Community-oriented urban development projects have been proven to help reverse negative consequences linked to declining, blighted infrastructure. Our joint exploration provides us the unique opportunity to create and nurture Peoria area partnerships, uphold our commitments to equitable investment in each neighborhood we serve, and strategically uplift residents by first rejuvenating their immediate common spaces via natural designs.



Nature-based solutions require stepping outside the comfort zone, trying creative non-obvious alternatives, and close collaboration between many different work fronts. This process is challenging, but not impossible, as we can see in the Bishan-Ang Mo Kio Park in Singapore.

A few decades ago, the city decided to channelize the Kallang River creating a linear fenced canal that was a clear dividing line between the park and community... The result is a blue-green infrastructure project that provides flood prevention and improved water quality, increasing the benefits of the canal to the community. Combining natural materials, civil engineering techniques, and plants that can filter and absorb water was essential to stabilize the riverbanks and prevent erosion.

In other words, besides all the environmental benefits from the improved flood management and water quality, and the positive impact on people's physical and mental well-being by bringing them closer to nature, this NBS has also generated significant financial savings, achieving great results for a fraction of the cost of traditional solutions".

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What is an Urban Development?

According to the Municipal Research and Services Center, "Urban design, as defined by the late University of Washington Professor Meyer Wolfe, is the 'manipulation of the physical environment' in a way that:

- Addresses the way people perceive and behave in their surroundings,
- Considers the implications of form-giving actions (including the environmental and ecological consequences) at a range of scales (sometimes from the individual to the regional),
- Pursues multiple objectives for multiple clients (including affected members of the public), and
- Is conducted through an explicit decision-making process that offers the public the opportunity to participate in a meaningful way, identifies goals and objectives, analyzes existing conditions, explores alternate concepts and solutions, evaluates options with respect to project goals and public values, selects the preferred alternative or combines preferred elements into a synthesized concept, and includes an implementation strategy.



Urban Design Addresses the Sensory Environment

Urban design addresses how people perceive and use their environment. People care about the look, feel, and livability of their communities, and urban design tools are a planner's most effective tools to address this need. To accomplish this, urban designers must be well-versed in the way human perception and behavior is affected by their physical surroundings, which also involves understanding cultural behaviors and preferences, economic factors, and functional activities associated with the physical environment.

- It describes a rational participatory process and provides a clear methodology for applying urban design concepts".²

Seoul's pollution-tackling 'wind path' forests

The South Korean capital should feel quite a bit cooler in the years to come. The city has just started planting a series of 'wind path' forests that aim to improve the circulation of clean air in the centre – and ultimately help cut temperatures in Seoul city centre by up to 7C in summer.

A series of pine and maple forests are being planted along rivers and roads, creating 'paths' that funnel clean, cool air down from Gwanaksan Mountain and Bukhansan Mountain, down to the centre. Oaks and wild cherry trees are also being planted to help purify the air by absorbing particulate matter (including various pollutants).

On top of all their environmental benefits, we're certain all these woods will be thoroughly lovely places to just chill and hang out, too.
