Administrative Procedure

SUBJECT: Unmanned Aircraft Systems Commercial Usage in Parks

In an effort to regulate commercial usage of unmanned aircraft systems (drones, quad copters, etc.) in parks and minimize the potential risk to park users, the following procedure will be implemented.

Commercial drone usage will be allowed at private rentals and specific Park District festivals only, unless otherwise preapproved by the Executive Director.

The Peoria Park District will create a list of drone qualified operators. Each operator will receive a Peoria Park District Drone Permit Number. To meet the requirements, operators must provide the following documentation:

- Proof of adherence to regulations identified in FAA Part 107 guidelines (operator certificate or license)
- · Current proof of insurance
- \$100.00 permit fee
- Signed Permit Agreement

Renewal (annually): Drone operator will coordinate directly with Parks Department

- Renewal fee of \$50.00
- Update insurance and drone permit waiver

For policing and regulating purposes, drone operator must have PPD drone permit number on his/her person during event.
