LITTLE EXPLORERS **OR** HABITAT ADVENTURE

LOCATION: Forest Park Nature Center
COST: \$5/students // \$0/chaperone
Consists of a focused, guided hike with a FPNC Naturalist.

PLAYHOUSE SPOTLIGHT

LOCATION: PlayHouse
COST: \$7/students // chaperone: one free/every 3 students**
Play at the PlayHouse and participate in a STEAM-based interactive classroom program.

JR. PIONEERING HOMESTEAD

LOCATION: Sommer Farm
COST: \$8/student // \$4/chaperone // \$0/teachers
MINIMUM COST: \$120 **LENGTH:** 2 hours

..... GRADES 2-12

HABITAT ADVENTURE GRADES K-3

LOCATION: Forest Park Nature Center
COST: \$5/students // \$0/chaperone
Consists of a focused, guided hike with a FPNC Naturalist.

PLAYHOUSE SPOTLIGHT GRADES 2-5

LOCATION: PlayHouse
COST: \$7/students // chaperone: one free/every 3 students**
Four thematic options, linked to Next Generation Science Standards, from which to choose: Construction, Down on the Farm, and Water.

PIONEERING HOMESTEAD GRADES 2-5

LOCATION: Sommer Farm
COST: \$10/student // \$5/chaperone // \$0/teachers
MINIMUM COST: \$150 **LENGTH:** 3.5 hours
Grades 2-5 can also do the Jr. Pioneering Homestead.

ELECTRICITY EXPLORATION GRADES 2-12

LOCATION: Peoria PlayHouse Children's Museum
COST: \$6/students // adults: one free/every 3 students**
How does electricity work? Students will learn through a guided team challenge to light up a mini-neighborhood. After this 45-60 minute workshop, children will have the opportunity to enjoy play time in the museum with their chaperones.
