Peoria Park District Track Chair Use Guidelines

The Peoria Park District strives to ensure equitable access to our parks and spaces. In order to increase accessibility to natural areas, we are pleased to provide two Action Track Chair units for public use at Forest Park Nature Center.

Trail Hours:	Trails open daily, dawn to dusk
Nature Center Hours:	Tuesday to Saturday, 9am to 5pm Sundays, 1pm to 5pm (Only April-October)
Track Chair Rental Hours:	Wednesday through Saturday, 10am-12pm or 1pm-3pm Availability is based upon the FPNC facility and program schedule

To make a reservation:

- Call Forest Park Nature Center at (309) 686-3360, or visit in person.
- Reservations must be made at least 48 hours in advance, no walk in time slots are available.
- Track Chairs may be available for use at select programs and special events, reservations are required. For safety reasons, Track Chairs can not be used after dark or during night hikes.
- Track Chairs are provided by the Peoria Park District free of charge for recreational use of our patrons. No commercial use is allowed. Chairs cannot be rented by outside organizations for private events.
- The Track Chairs can not be used in inclement weather (rain, snow, or ice). Staff have the right to cancel or reschedule a reservation based on weather and/ or trail conditions.
- A photo ID is required for rental.

Peoria Park District Track Chair Use Guidelines

Use Guidelines:

- All Track Chair users must sign a waiver, read the recommended use guidelines, and watch a required orientation video.
- Track chair users must be accompanied by a companion over the age of 18.
- Users are responsible for storage of their personal mobility devices while in the Track Chair. Peoria Park District staff cannot move or store personal devices.
- Peoria Park District staff can not transfer patrons between vehicles, mobility devices, and the Track Chairs. Users must be able to self transfer, or transfer with the assistance of a companion.
- Peoria Park District staff will bring the Track Chair to meet the user at the designated loading spot in front of the building.
- The user, or their parent/ guardian, is responsible for determining whether track chair use is within their abilities.

Safety Information

- The maximum weight for users is 300lb.
- Seat belt use is required at all times.
- Track Chairs can be adjusted for personal settings, such as the recline function of the back rest. Modifications to the chair or the addition of accessories are prohibited.
- Only one person is allowed in the chair at a time. Users cannot transport children or animals on their lap.
- Track Chairs must stay on the designated route. The route will be marked by signage, and a map will be available showing the designated trails. Track Chairs can not be used on stairs or steep inclines.
- The Peoria Park District strongly recommends that users keep a cell phone on them at all times when using the chair.
- Due to the potential of injury or entrapment to leashed service animals, we recommend that service animals be handled by a companion.
- Users must not operate the Track Chair under the influence of substances or medications that could impair the safe use of machinery.
- Closed toe shoes are recommended for safety reasons. While in operation, users should take care to avoid reaching towards the tracks.
- Recommended travel speed is level 3 or less.



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
